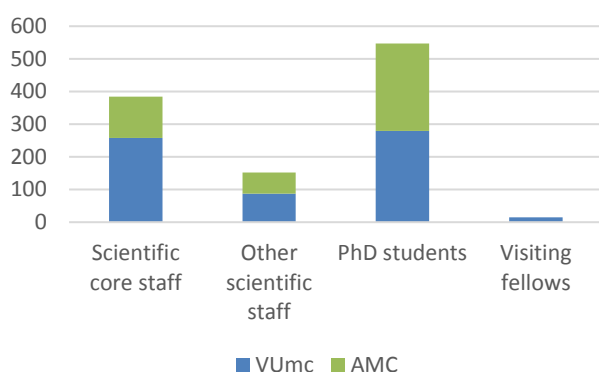

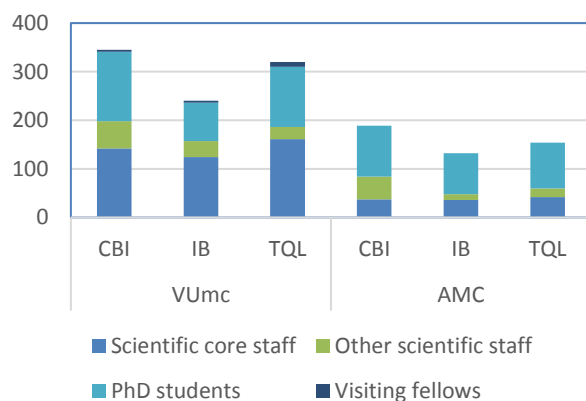

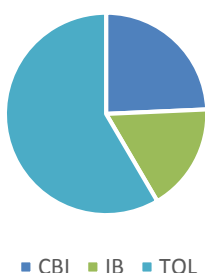
Refereed articles per program VUmc



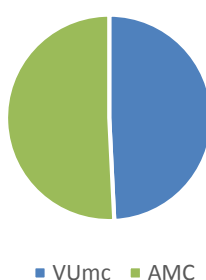
Refereed articles per program AMC
